Welcome to Heckington Players! As a member, you have joined an amazing amateur dramatic group which puts on 3 performances throughout the year, our famous January panto, a play in May and a play in September, all based at Heckington Village Hall. So, let me tell you what it means to be a member.

You are helping to support drama in the local area and to help keep us, a community drama group, going. Drama is a great way to express yourself and theatre is one of the oldest forms of entertainment going. Heckington Players also has a very rich history and now you can become part of that.

How about being an active member of our welcoming society? This does not just include acting on stage (although this does form quite a large part of it), we also ask our members to actively get involved in the various areas of backstage work, too. So, if you don't get cast or don't fancy being on stage, then there is plenty of work behind the scenes. This includes being part of the stage crew, set design and building, design and painting the backdrops, helping to source props, helping with costume, hair and make-up, directing, producing and helping out with Front of House, plus much much more, if you do get a part then we expect full commitment to every rehearsal throughout the show time period. We don't expect you to be involved in every single show, but we do ask that you help out as much as you can even if it is just to come and watch the show. We rehearse at the Village Hall from 7:45pm on a Thursday (or the 1st Wednesday of each month).

In return, there are some nice perks; for a start, as a member you can book tickets earlier than the general public (great for panto season), you are invited to attend after-show parties and group adult only socials (from evening meals to theatre trips and other events), and there are plenty of other little perks along the way.
